LOCATION: **Exit 399A just one mile off I-35E in Waxahachie**
Only 30 minutes south of the Downtowns of Dallas & Fort Worth at the Scarborough Faire® site. 1 hour north of Waco.

After being transformed over the last several years, Screams® has been further enhanced for its 24th season to provide the scariest Screams® experience ever! There are 5 haunted houses, each with a different theme – they are sure to find what terrifies you! Screams® is located in Waxahachie, just 30 minutes south of the Downtowns Dallas and Fort Worth off I-35E at exit 399A at the Scarborough Faire® site. Just one hour north of Waco. - Screams® has 9 make-up artists creating the make-up & effects for the actors
- Screams® employs more than 350 food service, performers, retail and grounds crew each year

OTHER INTERESTING FACTS – each year Screams® uses:

- 4,500 feet of air lines
- 12,000 feet of cable
- 2,500 lights
- 11 air compressors
- Over 100 speakers and 50 dedicated digital sound devices
- Nearly 4,800 man-hours of preparation
