- Screams® is held at the Scarborough Faire® site in Waxahachie, TX (2511 FM 66)
- Screams® is built “from the ground up” every year beginning in June soon after Scarborough Renaissance Festival® closes
- Screams® haunted houses encompass more than 15,000 square feet of frights
- Screams® event site is more than 20 acres in size
- 100+ actors will perform at Screams® in 2023
- Screams® has 9 make-up artists creating the make-up & effects for the actors
- Screams® employs more than 300 food service, performers, retail, grounds crew, and support personnel each year

- 2,500 lights
